132nd Annual Meeting ❖ San Diego, CA ❖ January 3-6, 2001

The 132nd Annual Meeting of the American Philological Association, in conjunction with the Archaeological Institute of America, is being held in San Diego, California, beginning January 3, 2001. The Annual Meeting will take place at the San Diego Marriott Hotel and Marina, 333 West Harbor Drive, San Diego, CA 92101-7700; Telephone (619) 234-1500. The Convention Registration Desk, the Exhibit Hall, the Placement Service, all AIA and APA paper sessions, committee meetings, receptions, and special events will be located in the Marriott. (Please note: this year *one* hotel will be sufficient for all sessions/events of *both* associations.)

REGISTRATION:

Registration is required for attendance at all sessions and for admission into the exhibit area. No one will be admitted into the exhibit area or meeting rooms without the official AIA/APA Annual Meeting badge.

ADVANCE REGISTRATION:

There are three advance registration deadlines:

Prize Rate Advance Registration — Nov. 10th: Reduced rate with a chance at two free registrations. All members who register by November 10th will be eligible for a drawing to receive a complimentary registration for the Joint Annual Meeting. There will be two awards. The winners' meeting registrations will be refunded.

Early Bird Advance Registration — Nov. 30th: Reduced rate registration. Registrations **received (not postmarked) by November 30, 2000**, will be accepted at the following reduced rates:

- APA and AIA members. \$90
- Non-members. \$135
- APA or AIA Student Members. \$35
- Student Non-members. \$75
- Non-professional Spouse/Member Guest. . \$35
- One-day registration. \$50

Membership in the societies will be verified. The spouse/guest category is for a non-professional or non-student guest accompanying a paid attendee. Only full-time student members are eli-

gible for the special student rate. All other students must pay the nonmember rate. Proof of full-time student status (*e.g.*, copy of student ID or a statement of status from department advisor or chair) must be sent with the registration form and payment. One-day registration is possible for a single day only; individuals wishing to attend for more than one day must register at the full rate.

Final Advance Registration — Dec. 20th: Regular, higher rate registration. Any advance registrations received after November 30, 2000, will be processed at the higher rate indicated on the registration form (listed below under On-Site Registration). All advance registration payments must be **received (not postmarked)** by December 20, 2000. This is a firm deadline: any forms received after this date will be processed on-site in San Diego.

Fees are payable in U.S. dollars with checks drawn on a U.S. bank, or by credit card (Visa or MasterCard). Members are strongly encouraged to send their registration forms early, and to make their hotel and travel reservations as soon as possible.

Advance registrants may pick up name badges, plus any additional items they have ordered, at the Registration desk in the Marina Ballroom Foyer Area on the Third Floor of the South Tower (one floor above the Lobby) of the San Diego Marriott Hotel and Marina during posted registration hours (see below).

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Registration fees will be refunded upon written request through December 15, 2000, and are subject to a \$15 administrative service fee. **Requests received after this date will not be honored.** These requests must be sent to the American Philological Association, 291 Logan Hall, University of Pennsylvania, 249 S. 36th Street, Philadelphia, PA 19104-6304. Refunds will be processed after the Annual Meeting and before February 15, 2001. Registrants are responsible for canceling their own hotel and travel reservations.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:

The **San Diego Marriott Hotel and Marina** (1-800-876-5030) is the headquarters hotel for the annual meeting and will provide sleeping room accommodations at the following reduced rates:

- Single/Double. \$99 per night
- Triple. \$119 per night
- Quadruple. \$139 per night

A limited number of suites are available at \$200 per night on a first-come, first-served basis. Rooms with a bay view may be guaranteed for an additional \$15 per night. Additional information about the Hotel is available from its web site: www.sdmarrriott.com.

Three other San Diego hotels, all within walking distance (5-10 minutes) of the Marriott, are reserving rooms for APA/AIA registrants. Their nightly room rates are as follows:

- The **Clarion Hotel Bay View San Diego** (Tel: 619-696-0234): \$89, single/double; \$109, triple/quadruple; \$189, suites

Important Note: Rates at all four hotels reserving rooms for the joint annual meeting are subject to applicable state and local taxes, currently 10.5%.

AIR TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:

American Airlines has been designated the official carrier for the 2001 APA Annual Meeting in San Diego. For round-trip travel to San Diego between December 29, 2000, and January 10, 2001, American offers 5% off of the lowest applicable fares. Reservations booked at least 60 days prior to departure will be made at a 10% discount off of the lowest fares available. This year American is also offering special discounted fares without a Saturday night stay; however, you must stay over two consecutive nights during the week. Fares are refundable for a full or partial refund after deduction of a \$75 fee.

LOCAL INFORMATION:

The San Diego Marriott Hotel and Marina is located in downtown San Diego on the San Diego Bay. It is close to Seaport Village and within easy walking distance of fine local shopping and restaurants. It is a taxi drive away from the Gaslamp Quarter, the San Diego Zoo, San Diego Wild Animal Park, and Sea World. A light rail line with a terminus in Tijuana has a stop at the foot of the small hill that leads to the Hotel. WEATHER:

Notwithstanding the current heat wave in Southern California, the average daily temperature in San Diego is 70.5 degrees Fahrenheit (21.4 degrees Celsius). In January last year the high temperature was 65 and the low was 48. Humidity averaged 63%. One rarely needs a top-coat (or raincoat) in the winter months. Evenings are almost always cool; so, be sure to bring a jacket or a sweater. The days are frequently quite warm.
